

Vadodara came to a standstill on kidney ailments and had undergone Friday as more than 15,000 of its dwellers lined the city's streets to bid adieu to Maharaja Shrimant Ranjitsinh Pratapsinh Gaekwad. He was laid to rest at Kirti Mandir, the royal family's cremation grounds. Seventy-four year old Ranjitsinh breathed his last on Wednesday to kidney ailments.

According to sources close to members of royal family, the late Maharaja had expressed his wish to honour his great grand father and former ruler Sayajirao Gaekwad with Bharat Ratna posthumously.

He served two terms as Congress MP from Vadodara seat, first in 1980 and again in 1984.

Ranjitsinhji enjoyed close ties with the Gandhi family, especially with Rajiv Gandhi and his wife Sonia, in whose honour he had hosted a dinner at his Laxmi Palace in 1986. Chief Minister Narendra Modi and
